

it would have been held and enjoyed by Klaus Kramer-Massow, if this assignment and sale had not been made.

Klaus Kramer-Massow hereby represents and warrants that there are no rights or interests outstanding which are inconsistent with any of the rights and interests granted herein and that Klaus Kramer-Massow will not execute any instrument or grant or transfer any rights or interests inconsistent therewith, and Klaus Kramer-Massow binds himself and his heirs, executors, administrators, employees and legal representatives, as the case may be, to execute and deliver to Groupe Procycle, Inc., its successors and assigns, any further documents or instruments and do any and all further acts that may be deemed necessary by Groupe Procycle, Inc., its successors and assigns to file and prosecute any applications for reissue of said United States patent 6,244,610, and to prosecute any interference(s) or reexamination(s) which may relate to said United States patent 6,244,610 and/or that may be necessary to vest in Groupe Procycle, Inc., its successors and assigns, the title herein conveyed, or intended so to be, and to enable such title to be recorded in the United States.

AND, Klaus Kramer-Massow further covenants and agrees, in consideration of the premises, that he, his executors and administrators will, at any time upon request, communicate to Groupe Procycle, Inc., its successors and assigns, any facts relating to the said invention and improvements and the history thereof, known to him or his successors and assigns, and that he will testify as to the same in any interference or other

proceeding when requested to do so by Groupe Procycle, Inc., its successors and assigns.

The undersigned hereby grants the law firm of Birch, Stewart, Kolasch & Birch, LLP the power to insert on this Assignment any further identification which may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with the rules of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office for recordation of this document.
