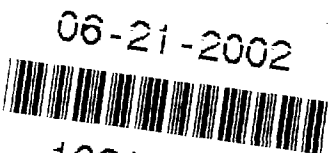

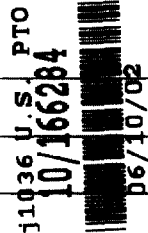

## ASSIGNMENT


