# ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, I, the undersigned, hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR, " have invented certain new and useful improvements as described and set forth in the below-identified application which is being filed in the United States Patent Office for the purpose of obtaining a United States Letters Patent:

Title of the Invention: **PROCESS AND SYSTEM FOR RECOVERING ENERGY FROM CARBON-CONTAINING MATERIALS**

Other identifying information: The invention is fully described and set forth in PCT Application PCT/AU00/01199 filed 29 September 2000 and claiming priority from Australian Provisional Application No. PQ3143 filed 29 September 1999, a copy of which has been provided to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

WHEREAS, World Oasis Australia Pty Ltd., an Australian Corporation having a place of business at Library Arcade No. 1, 470 High Street, Maitland, New South Wales 2320, AUSTRALIA, hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE," is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in the said invention and application and in any Letters Patent which may be granted on the same in the United States or anywhere in the world;

ASSIGNOR further agrees that ASSIGNOR will, without charge to said ASSIGNEE, but at ASSIGNEE's expense, cooperate with ASSIGNEE in the prosecution of said application and/or applications, execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver all such further papers, including applications for Letters Patent and for the reissue thereof, and instruments of assignment and transfer thereof, and will perform such other acts as ASSIGNEE lawfully may request, to obtain or maintain Letters Patent for said invention and improvement in any and all countries, and to vest title thereto in said ASSIGNEE, or ASSIGNEE's successors or assigns.
