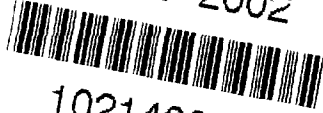

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Eugene Y. Ivanov, of 3198 Windsor Place, Grove City, Ohio 43123; and Harry W.
