PATENT ASSIGNMENT

2. The Corporation further sells, assigns, transfers and conveys unto said TDD, LLC the entire right, title and interest in and to any and all causes of action and rights of recovery for past infringement of the U.S. letters patent herein conveyed.

The terms of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of TDD, LLC as of the 24th day of January, 2002.
