

have made new and useful improvements in **AN IMAGE PROCESSING METHOD FOR USE IN ANALYZING DATA OF A CHEMOTAXIS OR HAPTOTAXIS ASSAY**, for which an application for Letters Patent was filed on March 15, 2002, under U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/097,302; and

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our name or in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under an International Convention or otherwise.

3. 4. 
