WHEREAS we, **David Strand**, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 16 Nason Hill Lane, Sherborn, MA 01770, USA; **Peter Myers**, a citizen of the United Kingdom, residing at 19 Woodlea Close, Bromborough, Wirral, United Kingdom L626DL; and **Tim Myers**, a citizen of the United Kingdom, residing at 1, Hyacinth Grove, Wirral, United Kingdom CH46 1SW, are the inventors of certain new and useful improvements or inventions in **Fluid Separation Conduit Cartridge with Encryption Capability** (herein after referred to as the "Invention"), for which we have filed on October 6, 2000, a United States Provisional Application, assigned by the United States Patent and Trademark Office Application No. 06/238,805 (hereinafter referred to as "Provisional Application"), and for which we have filed on October 5, 2001 an application of that name under the Patent Cooperation treaty designating multiple countries including the United States, assigned International Patent Application No. PCT/US01/31295 (hereinafter referred to as the "PCT Application"), and for which we have filed on December 27, 2001 an application of that name for Letters Patent of the United States, assigned by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office U.S. Application No. 10/034,757 (hereinafter referred to as the "Application"), both the Application and the PCT Application each claiming priority benefit of provisional patent application No. 60/238,805 filed on October 6, 2000 and provisional patent application No. 60/239,063 filed on October 6, 2000 and provisional patent application No. 60/239,010 and provisional patent application No. 60/238,390 filed on October 6, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Protasis Corporation (hereafter "Protasis"), a corporation organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, having its principal place of business at 734 Forest Street, Marlborough, Massachusetts 01752, County of Middlesex, Massachusetts is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Invention, the Provisional Application, the Application, the PCT Application and in and to any and all Letters Patent and foreign patents which may be granted on or as a result thereof in any country:

NOW, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, we by these presents do sell, assign and transfer to Protasis, its successors, assigns and legal representatives (hereinafter "Nominees"), the full and exclusive right, title, and interest for the United States of America and all other countries in and to the Invention, the Provisional Application, the Application, and the PCT Application, and we hereby request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent to Protasis, as the assignee;

AND WE authorize Protasis or its Nominees to file in my name or their own, an appropriate application for Letters Patent in all countries of the world, and we authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any proper official of any country, to issue to said Protasis or its Nominees any and all Letters Patent for said Invention for their sole use, to the full end of the term for which such Letters Patent may be granted.

AND WE covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed and will not execute any agreement or do anything in conflict herewith:

AND WE FURTHER convey to said assignee the entire right, title and interest in any application made in its own behalf for protection of said Invention in all countries and we do hereby covenant that we will without undue delay at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as said assignee may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, continuation, divisional, renewal, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United States or of any and all other countries on said Invention, and in enforcing any rights or causes of action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, and by executing preliminary statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure the benefit of, the assigns and legal representatives of both parties.
