



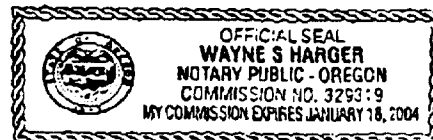

Price: The purchase price for the Patent shall be \$30,000.00


