

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I Daniel L. Grooms, residing at 2315 White Pine Dr., Williamston, Michigan 48895 have invented jointly with EVANGELYN C. ALOCILJA, STEVE A. MARQUIE, CYNTHIA MEEUSEN and SPRING M.
