PATENT ASSIGNMENT


WHEREAS, Charles J. Burstone of 252 Old Mountain Road, Farmington, CT, together with others, has made a certain invention entitled Pseudoelastic β Titanium Alloy and Uses Therefor, for which a patent application was filed in the United States on March 5, 1999 and which was assigned Serial No. 09/263,658, and has been issued as U.S. Letters Patent No. 6,258,182 (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor").

Assignor further covenants and agrees that he will and that each of his legal representatives shall execute and deliver any and all application papers, assignments, powers of attorney and other instruments that said Assignee, may deem necessary or advisable to secure or to enforce Letters Patents for said invention and any divisions, continuations, reissues, extensions and renewals thereof, and to vest and confirm in said Assignee, the full and complete legal and equitable title that Assignor possesses to any such applications of Letters Patents and any Letters Patents issuing thereon.
