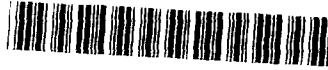



Due to a clerical error when the application transmittal was filed, Inventor No. 1 and Inventor No. 6 were duplicated.


