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AGREEMENT OF LIEN ON
PATENTS

THIS AGREEMENT, by OWEN INDUSTRIES, INC., an Iowa corporation, having its principal place of business at 501 Avenue H, Carter Lake, Iowa 51510 (the "Grantor"), in favor of GE Capital CFE, Inc., having its principal place of business at 201 High Ridge Road, Stamford, Connecticut, 06927, as Agent for the Secured Parties referred to below (in such capacity, together with its successors in such capacity, the "Agent").

Recitals:

A. The Grantor has obtained certain Letters Patent of the United States and/or foreign countries and has certain applications for Letters Patent pending in the United States and/or foreign countries, all of which Letters Patent and pending applications are more particularly described hereinafter.

B. Owen Industries, Inc. and Richard F. Owen Companies, Inc. (f/k/a Central Plains Steel Co.), as borrowers, the Banks party thereto from time to time (the "Banks") and the Agent are party to that certain Revolving Line of Credit Agreement dated as of July 7, 1995, as amended by the First Amendment to Revolving Line of Credit Agreement dated as of March 12, 1996, the Second Amendment to Revolving Line of Credit Agreement dated as of February 28, 1997, the Third Amendment to Revolving Line of Credit Agreement dated as of August 27, 1997, the Fourth Amendment to Revolving Line of Credit Agreement and Joinder dated as of January 1, 1999, and the Fifth Amendment to Revolving Line of Credit Agreement, dated as of September 28, 2001 (as further amended, supplemented, restated, or modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement").

C. The Grantor and the Agent entered into a Security Agreement dated as of September 28, 2001 (as amended from time to time, the "Security Agreement"). Pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Grantor has granted to and created in favor of the Agent, for the benefit of the Banks and the Agent (collectively, the "Secured Parties"), to secure the Secured Obligations (as defined in the Security Agreement), a lien on and security interest in certain property of the Grantor, including the Letters Patent and pending applications referred to above.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Grantor, intending to be legally bound, hereby confirms that it has granted to and created in favor of the Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, pursuant to the Security Agreement, and hereby grants to and creates in favor of the Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, a lien on and security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the following Letters Patent and pending applications, as security for the full and timely payment and performance of the Secured Obligations:

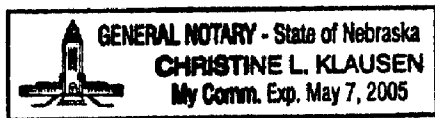

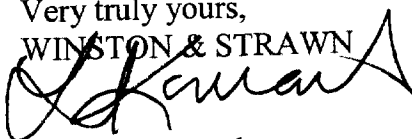
