ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS is entered into this 1st day of March, 2002, by DeRoyal Business Systems, LLC, a Tennessee limited liability company, d/b/a iPath ("iPath"), in favor of GE Medical Systems Information Technologies, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation ("GEMS-IT").

WHEREAS, iPath and GEMS-IT are parties to a certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of February 8, 2002 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which GEMS-IT has agreed to purchase certain assets of iPath, and iPath has agreed to cause the same to be transferred, assigned and contributed to GEMS-IT upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement;

WHEREAS, iPath owns all right, title and interest in and to and is the sole exclusive owner of the United States patents and patent applications listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein (the "Patents"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, iPath desires to assign and transfer to GEMS-IT all of its right, title and interest in and to the Patents and GEMS-IT is desirous of acquiring the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the foregoing recited consideration and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, iPath does hereby assign, sell and transfer to GEMS-IT all of its right, title and interest in and to the Patents and inventions disclosed therein, including any U.S. or foreign continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, renewals, reissues, reexaminations and extensions thereof, together with all claims for damages by reason of past infringement thereof, with the right to sue for, and collect the same for GEMS-IT's own use and benefit. iPath further consents to the recordation of this Assignment of Patents by GEMS-IT with the Commissioner of Patents. GEMS-IT agrees to assume responsibility for recording fees and other costs associated with recording of title to the Patents.

This Assignment of Patents shall be binding upon iPath, its successors and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of GEMS-IT and its successors and assigns.
