ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Peter K. Bostwick of 8132 Braddock Drive, St. Louis, Missouri 63130, Daniel E. Bailey of 453 Seton Hall Ct., Valley Park, Missouri 63088, Nathan C. Owen of 14 Claire Drive, Florissant, Missouri 63031, Philip S. Johnson of 2049 State Street, Granite City, Illinois 62040, and Barry M. Newberg of 3920 Fleur Du Bois, Florissant, Missouri 63034, have invented certain new and useful improvements for a *OPTIMIZED THERMAL SYSTEM FOR AN ELECTRIC MOTOR* for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent in the United States identifying us as the only inventors thereof (said application being identified as Thompson Coburn LLP, Docket 60033/8628); and
