ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Chad P. Paris, residing at 6-3 Kings Court, Camillus, NY 13031; Scott W. Osiecki, residing at 47 East Street, Skaneateles NY 13152; and Peter F. Lynch, residing at County Line Road, Skaneateles, NY 13152 have invented certain new and useful improvements in a LIGHTING DEVICE for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.
