20 confusingly similar to the distinct FREEDOM ARM keyboard
21 support mechanism; and

22 2. Further distributing the FREEDOM ARM keyboard support
23 mechanism within the United States and/or shipping FREEDOM ARM
24 keyboard support mechanisms into the United States; and

25 3. Further misappropriating, using or disclosing
26 SoftView's Proprietary Information, including schematics,
27 mechanical drawings, prototypes, tooling and molds relating to
28 SoftView's FREEDOM ARM.
