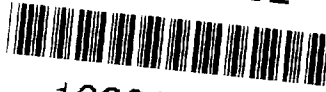

## **ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION**

WHEREAS, I, John Nash, residing at 1201 North Chester Springs Road, P.O. Box 348, Chester Springs, Pennsylvania 19425, along with other inventors, have made several new and useful inventions regarding devices and systems for measuring blood viscosity and methods of using the same and all of which are known as "Blood Viscosity Technology", hereinafter referred to as "BVT inventions" and have filed applications for Letters Patent of the United States and elsewhere based thereon, the BVT inventions and patent applications, and patents issuing from the patent applications, being listed in the attached Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, I, John Nash, am an employee of KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and having an office and place of business at 55 East Uwchlan Avenue, Suite 204, Exton, PA 19341;

WHEREAS, I, John Nash, am under an obligation to assign all of my rights related to the BVT inventions, patent applications and patents to KENSEY NASH CORPORATION;

WHEREAS, KENSEY NASH CORPORATION is desirous of acquiring my entire right, title and interest in and to the BVT inventions and any improvements thereon which may be made, conceived or acquired by me in and throughout the United States and its territories pursuant to and during my employment by KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, and for one year thereafter, and which form the subject matter of the United States pending patent applications and patents identified in Exhibit A attached hereto, and in and to any patents, or extensions thereof, issuing from said United States pending patent applications

(all of the BVT inventions and any improvements thereon which may be made, conceived or acquired by me in and throughout the United States and its territories pursuant to and during my employment by KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, and for one year thereafter, the United States pending patent applications and the patents identified in Exhibit A, and any patents, or extensions thereof, issuing from the United States pending patent applications hereinafter being collectively referred to as "PATENT RIGHTS"); and in and to all divisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other United States patent applications based upon the PATENT RIGHTS, and any patents, or extensions thereof, issuing from any of the divisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other United States patent applications based upon the PATENT RIGHTS (the PATENT RIGHTS and all divisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other United States patent applications based upon the PATENT RIGHTS, and any patents, or extensions thereof, issuing from any of the divisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other United States patent applications based upon the PATENT RIGHTS being collectively referred to as "UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS"); and in and to all foreign patent applications based upon the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and any and all foreign patents granted on the foreign patent applications (the foreign patent applications based upon the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and any and all foreign patents granted on the foreign patent applications being collectively referred to as "FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS");

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, John Nash, by these presents do sell, assign and transfer unto KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, my entire right, title and interest in and to the UNITED STATES PATENT

RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS;

TO BE HELD AND ENJOYED by KENSEY NASH CORPORATION and its legal representatives and assigns to the full ends of the terms for which any Letters Patent that have been granted or may be granted on the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me had no sale and assignment of the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS been made; and I do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner for Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent which may be granted upon the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS to KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, and I hereby agree for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to execute without further consideration, any further legal documents and any further assignments and any releases, reissues, renewals or other applications for Letters Patent that may be deemed necessary by KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, fully to secure to KENSEY NASH CORPORATION its interest as aforesaid in and to the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS.

I do hereby covenant for myself and my legal representatives, and agree with KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, and its legal representatives, that I have granted no license to make or sell the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS, that prior to the execution of this assignment my right, title and interest in the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS have not been encumbered, that I have good right and title in and to the UNITED STATES PATENT RIGHTS and the FOREIGN PATENT RIGHTS and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict therewith.
