ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION AND PATENT APPLICATION

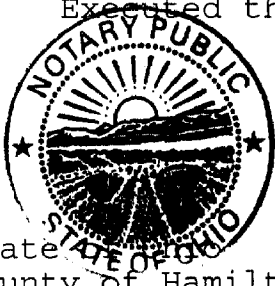
