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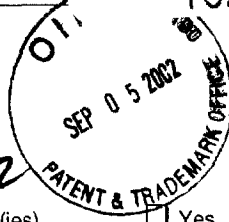

A S S I G N M E N T

We, Richard J. Linder, Daryl R. Edmiston, and Steven W. Johnson of Rubicon Medical, Inc. have invented a method and apparatus entitled METHODS, SYSTEMS, AND DEVICES FOR PROVIDING EMBOLIC PROTECTION hereinafter called the "invention."


