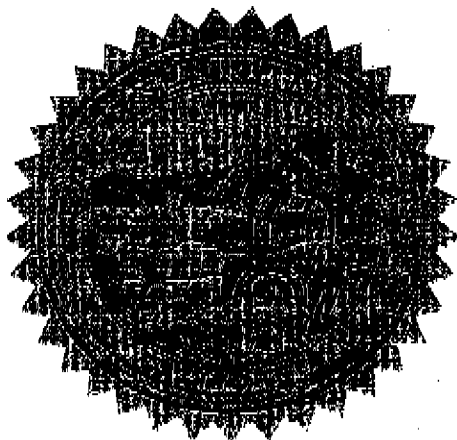

**AMENDED AND RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF HYPERBARIC SYSTEMS,
A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION**

The undersigned, Harry Masuda and Paul Okimoto, hereby certify
that:

BILL JONES, Secretary of State

1. They are the duly elected and acting President and Secretary respectfully of
Hyperbaric Systems, a California corporation (the "Corporation");

2. The Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation are amended and restated to read in
full as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Human BioSystems.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a
corporation may be organized under the General Corporation Law of California other than the
banking business, the trust company business or the practice of a profession permitted to be
incorporated by the California Corporations Code.

ARTICLE III

This Corporation is authorized to issue two classes of shares to be designated respectively
common stock ("Common Stock") and preferred stock ("Preferred Stock"). The total number of
shares of capital stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is fifty million
(50,000,000) shares, of which forty-five million (45,000,000) shares shall be Common Stock, and
five million (5,000,000) shares shall be Preferred Stock. The Board of Directors of the
corporation is hereby authorized to provide for the issue of all or any of the shares of the
Preferred Stock in one or more series, and to fix the number of shares and to determine or alter,
for each such series, such powers, designations, preferences and relative participating, optional or
other rights and such qualifications, limitations or restrictions thereof, as shall be stated and
expressed in the resolution or resolutions adopted by the Board of Directors providing for the
issue of such series and as may be permitted by the General Corporation Law of the State of
California.

ARTICLE IV

- (A) The liability of the directors of this Corporation for
monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest
extent permissible under California law.
- (B) This Corporation is authorized to indemnify agents of
this Corporation, including without limitation,
directors and officers, whether by bylaw, agreement or
otherwise, to the fullest extent permissible under

California Law, and in excess of that expressly permitted by Section 317 of the California Corporation Law.

3. The foregoing amendment has been approved by the Board of Directors of this Corporation.

4. The foregoing amendment was approved by the holders of the requisite number of shares of this Corporation in accordance with sections 902 and 903 of the California General Corporation Law. The total number of outstanding shares of each class entitled to vote with respect to the foregoing amendment was 19,198,685 shares of Common Stock. The number of shares voting in favor of the foregoing amendment equal or exceeded the vote required, such required vote being a majority of the outstanding shares of Common Stock.


