ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS ("Assignment"), dated as of August 1, 2002, is made from SUDDEN SERVICE, INC., a Mississippi corporation ("Assignor"), with its principal place of business located at 650 North Church Street, Louisville, Mississippi 39339, to THE TAYLOR GROUP, INC., a Mississippi corporation ("Assignee"), with its principal place of business in 650 North Church Street, Louisville, Mississippi 39339.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole owner of certain inventions and designs and the related patent rights identified on Schedule A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, for which United States Letters Patent have been issued or will be issued (the inventions, designs, and Letters Patent are referred to herein collectively as the "Patents"); and

WHEREAS, Assignee desires to acquire the entire right, title and interest of Assignor in and to the Patents;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor and Assignee hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patents, including but not limited to all United States Letters Patent which have been granted or may be granted therefor, and all divisions, reissues, continuations and extensions thereof, said interest being the entire ownership of said Patents including any and all Letters Patent when granted, to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made, and all causes of action, claims, and demands or other rights for, or arising from, any infringement, including past infringements, of the Patents.

2. Assignor further agrees, without further consideration, to perform such other lawful acts and execute such further assignments and other lawful documents as Assignee may from time to time request to effect fully this Assignment and to permit Assignee to be duly recorded as the registered owner or proprietor of each of the rights hereby conveyed. Assignor further authorizes and requests that the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks issue any pending applications for Letters Patent directly to Assignee.

3. Subject to the terms hereof, Assignee hereby accepts such assignment of the Trademarks.
