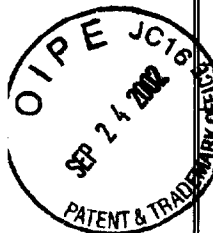

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Matthew S. Cowlen, Benjamin R. Yerxa, Arthur C. Jones, and Edward G. Brown, being citizens of the United States of America, residing at 208 Clark Lake Road, Chapel Hill, North Carolina 27707, 3119 Birnamwood Road, Raleigh, North Carolina 27607, 5 Winnabow Court, Durham, North Carolina 27703, and 302 Glenmore Road, Cary, North Carolina 27519, all of the United States of America, respectively, have made new and useful improvements in *Joint Lubrication with P₂Y Purinergic Receptor Agonists*, for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on June 25, 2002, as Application No. 10/183,320.

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our name or in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise.




