 and reissues and extensions of said Letters Patent or Patents, and all rights under the
 International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the same to be held and
 enjoyed by the Assignee, for its own use and behalf and the use and behalf of its successors,
 legal representatives, and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which Letters Patent
 or Patents may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and
 enjoyed by the Assignors had this sale and assignment not been made;
