## ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, I, Brian M. O'Connor, 1180 S.W. Catalina Street, Palm City, Florida 34990 have invented a certain new and useful improvement in a Trailer-Mounted Trench Burner for which an application for Letters Patent in the United States was executed on the date which appears next to my signature.
