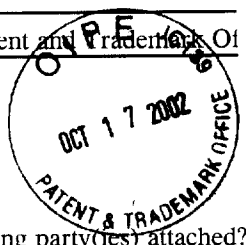

and which has been accorded Application No. 10/201684


