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

WHEREAS, I, DAVID HUNTINGTON, a citizen of Great Britain, residing at 30 Bovey Tracey Park, Bovey Tracey, Devon TQ13 9QT, as assignor, have made an invention entitled "SOLID STATE CAPACITORS AND METHODS OF MANUFACTURING THEM" as described in a patent application for U.S. Letters Patent, bearing U.S. Serial No. 10/030,569 which was filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on January 4, 2002 (and having a priority date of July 8, 1999); and
