

Eduard Svyatsky, a citizen of the United States of America presently residing at

29845 River Drive, Libertyville, IL 60048 (U.S.A.);

(referred to as "Assignor", "he", or "him"), has invented and presently owns the Inventions covered by the following issued United States Patent:

- (1) United States Patent No. 4,892,300, issued on January 9, 1990, from application Ser. No. 198,472, filed May 25, 1988, and entitled, "Differential document drive";

WHEREAS. BELL & HOWELL COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Delaware, having a place of business at 3400 W. Pratt Avenue, Lincolnwood, IL 60721 (U.S.A.) NOW, THEREFORE, TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the Assignors, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Assignor, has sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over, unto the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in, to and under (1) the Inventions, and all applications for Letters Patent that may have been, or hereafter be filed for said Inventions in any country and (2) the United States Patent(s), including, without limitation, all extensions, renewals, reissues, reexaminations and the like thereof and such other forms of protection of industrial property as may be or have been provided by any country, and all rights of priority in any country that are based upon the filing date of the above-identified United States Patent(s) and that are created by any law, treaty or international convention; the above transferred right, title and interest (including the right to collect damages for past infringements thereof) to be held and enjoyed *nunc pro tunc* as of May 25, 1988, by said Assignee, its successors and assigns as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignors had this assignment not been made;

ASSIGNOR HEREBY authorizes and requests all appropriate and competent Officials in all countries, whose duty it is to issue or grant Letters Patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue or grant all Letters Patent for said Invention to the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument;

ASSIGNOR HEREBY represents and covenants that he has the full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned and that he has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith;

ASSIGNOR HEREBY further covenants and agrees that, at the request and expense of the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, but without demanding further consideration therefor, they will (1) assist in the prosecution of all applications for Letters Patent as herein described and any other applications for Letters Patent that may be made covering said Invention; (2) communicate any and all facts known to them respecting said Invention; (3) testify in any legal proceeding involving said Invention; (4) execute and acknowledge all lawful papers and legal instruments; (5) execute all divisional, continuing, reissue and reexamination applications; (6) make all rightful oaths; and (6) generally do any and every lawful act deemed necessary to aid and cooperate with the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns in perfecting
