WHEREAS, HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY, a Delaware corporation having its principal place of business in Palo Alto, California (hereinafter "HP"), is a joint owner, by assignment, of the United States Patent 5,400,354.

AND WHEREAS, AGILENT TECHNOLOGIES, INC., a Delaware corporation having its principal place of business in Palo Alto, California (hereinafter "AGILENT"), desires to acquire joint ownership in the entire right, title and interest, including the right of priority, in, to and under the United States Patent 5,400,354 .



Agilent Technologies, Inc. wishes to notify you that as part of the strategic realignment of the businesses of Hewlett-Packard Company (*HP*) to create two independent companies, HP transferred its measurements businesses comprising HP's Test and Measurements Organisation, Medical Products Group, Semiconductor Products Group and Chemical Analysis Group into a new company called Agilent Technologies, Inc. (*Agilent*). Agilent will continue to design, manufacture and sell components, equipment systems and services for use in a variety of applications. Agilent was demerged from HP with effect from 1 November 1999. As part of the demerger, HP agreed to transfer its interest in certain patents to Agilent.

We are contacting the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois because you jointly own the patent(s) and/or patent application(s) set out in the annex to this letter (the *Patents*) with HP. This letter serves to notify you of, and solicit your written consent to, the assignment by HP of its interest in the Patents to Agilent.


