

## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Satoru Matsumora, Shunetsu Sato and Toru Sasaki

hereinafter called the "Assignors", have made the invention described in the United States patent application entitled CONDUCTIVE RESIN COMPOSITION AND ELECTRODE SUBSTRATE USING THE SAME AND METHOD OF MANUFACTURING THE ELECTRODE SUBSTRATE, executed by Assignors on the same date as this Assignment;

The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is hereby authorized and requested to issue patents to the Assignee in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
