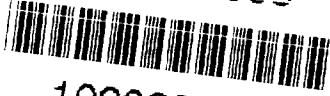

WHEREAS, I, John T. Swider (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor") have made an invention entitled SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR CONTAMINATION DETECTION WITHIN SEALED CONTAINERS, for which an application for a United States Patent is about to be filed.



Assignor further covenants and agrees to communicate to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to Assignor respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, including, without limitation, application papers, assignments, powers of attorney, declarations, and other instruments, execute all divisional, continuing, substitute, reissue, renewal and foreign applications, make all truthful oaths, declarations and statements, and generally do everything reasonably requested of Assignor by Assignee, or its successors or assigns to aid Assignee, its successors or assigns, to obtain, enforce and /or exploit said invention.


