## Confirmatory Assignment


Reference is made to that certain letter agreement (the "Agreement") dated February 24, 1995, regarding the "Feasibility Study for the Application of Hydrodynamics and Other Principles to Filtration Devices" between Millipore Corporation ("Millipore") and Atlantic Applied Research Corporation ("AARC"). Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein are used herein with the meanings assigned to them in the Agreement.

By letter dated October 4, 2001 and pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Agreement, Millipore provided written notice to each of AARC and Prodyne Corporation ("Prodyne") of Millipore's discontinuance of financial support of the prosecution or maintenance of patent protection for the Joint Development. Millipore hereby confirms that, pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Agreement, Millipore is deemed to have assigned its rights in the Joint Development to Prodyne and Prodyne shall be responsible for prosecuting patent protection for the Joint Development if Prodyne desires to obtain such protection.

This Confirmatory Assignment is provided without prejudice to any residual rights of Millipore (or its assignee, Mykrolis Corporation) under the Agreement, including the right to receive from Prodyne 50% of any consideration received with respect to the licensing, use or application of the Joint Invention within the Field, as set forth in Section 6(b) of the Agreement. This Confirmatory Assignment is further provided without prejudice to the positions asserted by AARC, Prodyne, Millipore or any other party in the adversary proceeding styled *Aquino v. Africk et al. (In re Atlantic Applied Research Corp.)*, Adv. Pro. No. 00-1160, Chapter 7 Case No. 98-14611-JNF, pending before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Massachusetts.

For your benefit, the status of the patent estate is as follows:


