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**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, Centocor, Inc., of 200 Great Valley Parkway, Malvern, PA 19355 (Centocor) has acquired all domestic and foreign right, title, and interest in the inventions of NANCY CHANG described in applications for Letters Patent of the United States U.S. Application Serial Nos. 08/080,387 and 08/462,504; and

WHEREAS, NANCY CHANG was an employee of Centocor at the time the inventions described and claimed in said applications were made;

WHEREAS, the conditions under which said inventions were made are such as to entitle the Centocor to the entire right, title, and interest therein;

WHEREAS, NANCY CHANG duly assigned and transferred her rights in said inventions to Centocor as evidenced by assignment in parent U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 06/693,866 filed January 23, 1985 recorded by the Assignment Branch of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on March 28, 1985 at Reel 4417, Frames 030-031;

WHEREAS, said assignment specifically included assignment of the rights in "any continuation, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, or extensions thereof";

WHEREAS, U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/080,387 was filed on June 21, 1993 as a continuation of U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 06/693,866 and U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/462,504 was filed on June 5, 1995 as a continuation of U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/080,387;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the terms of Section 6.2 of the Settlement Agreement dated December 1, 1994 between Institute Pasteur, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centocor, Inc. and E.I. DuPont de Nemours and Company and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Centocor hereby assigns and transfers to the

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the full and exclusive rights in and to said invention in the United States of America, its Territories and Possessions, and the entire right, title, and interest in and to such applications, and any continuations, reissues or extensions thereof, and including priority rights as may be filed in the U.S., and such Letters

Patent as may be granted to be held by INSTITUT PASTEUR to the end of the term for which the same would have been held had this assignment not been made.

Centocor further agrees to make, execute, and deliver to INSTITUT PASTEUR, upon request, any and all papers, documents, affidavits, or other instruments that may be necessary in the prosecution of any application or applications for improvements or reissues of Letters Patent, and to assist INSTITUT PASTEUR in every way as may be requested in protecting said invention, provided that any expense of extending such assistance shall be paid by INSTITUT PASTEUR.
