ASSIGNMENT – USA PATENT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, WE (1) Jean-Christophe P. Gabriel, a French citizen, residing at 1205 McDonald Ave., Pinole, CA 94564; (2) Philip G. Collins, a U.S. citizen, residing at 25 Twain St., Irvine, CA 92612; (3) Keith Bradley, a U.S. citizen, 3936 Patterson Ave., Oakland, CA 94619; (4) George Gruner, a U.S. citizen, residing at 960 Kenfield Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90049, hereinafter referred to as Assignor (collectively if more than one inventor is listed above), have invented certain new and useful improvements in **MODIFICATION OF SELECTIVITY FOR SENSING FOR NANOSTRUCTURE SENSING DEVICE ARRAYS**, the specification of which is attached hereto;

AND ASSIGNOR HEREBY covenants and agrees that it will communicate to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to it respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in the United States of America.


