ORDER OF TURNOVER

On August 13, 2002, came on to be heard Commercial Loan Corporation's Application for Turnover Relief against Richard D. Blackmore. The Court finds that a judgment was entered on May 28, 2002, in favor of Plaintiff against Defendant, in the principal sum of sixty-four thousand thirty-two and 85/100 dollars (\$64,032.85), that the Judgment was entered in Dallas County, Texas on June 26, 2002, and further finds that the Judgment is in all things final, valid, and subsisting, and is wholly unsatisfied. The Court, having considered the evidence, is of the opinion that relief should be granted and the following orders made to assist in obtaining satisfaction of the judgment rendered by this Court on June 26, 2002. It is therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Richard D. Blackmore turn over to Dallas County Constable Derrick Evans, Precinct 1, at 7201 South Polk, Dallas, Texas 75237, by August 27, 2002:


- (a) Any and all of Blackmore's ownership interest in Patent Number 5,591,291, titled Method of Forming Advanced Cured Resin Composite Parts, and all documents related thereto;
- (b) Any and all of Blackmore's ownership interest in Patent Number 5,656,231, titled Method of Forming Advanced Cured Resin Composite Parts, and all documents related thereto;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Constable Derrick Evans, Precinct 1, take possession of the Property ordered to be delivered to him, levy on such property as under writ of execution, and, after giving notice of sale, sell the property at public auction to the highest bidder for cash, applying the proceeds of the sale to payment of the expenses of sale and court costs, with the balance paid over to Commercial Loan Corporation for crediting on the judgment of this Court dated June 26, 2002. In so doing, the Constable shall perform all duties and procedures as required by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure for sale under writ of execution.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Commercial Loan Corporation recover from Richard D. Blackmore attorneys' fees in the sum of Two-Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$2,500.00) for services rendered in this proceeding through the time of this Order. In the event Defendant appeals to the Court of Appeals, if the appeal is unsuccessful, Commercial Loan Corporation shall be entitled to \$10,000.00 as additional reasonable attorneys' fees; in the event Blackmore petitions the Supreme Court of Texas and is unsuccessful, Commercial Loan Corporation shall be entitled to an additional \$15,000.00 as reasonable attorneys' fees. The sum so awarded may be collected along with the sums due under the judgment described in this Order and by the methods set forth above, and by any other process or remedy available.

All relief not expressly granted herein is DENIED.
