The undersigned (individually and collectively, "Assignor"), having the addresses listed on the signature pages hereof, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, by these presents have sold, assigned, transferred, granted, conveyed and set over, and by these presents sell, **assign, transfer and set over unto E. S. Robbins, III**, having an address at 2802 East Avalon Avenue, Muscle Shoals, Alabama 35661 ("Assignee"), and his successors, assigns and legal representatives, all right, title and interest, for all countries, in and to all the rights and privileges under any and **all Letters Patent described on Exhibit "A"** hereto and all reissues and extensions thereof; all inventions described in the applications for Letters Patent of the United States in respect thereof, and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications; and all forms of industrial property protection, including without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs which may be granted for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property on applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to **E. S. Robbins, III**, his successors, assigns and legal representatives, or to such nominees as he may designate.

Assignor hereby consents that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document which may be required in any country for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of the assignee or nominee to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.



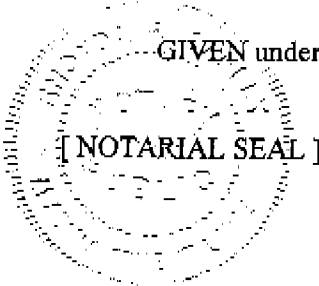
