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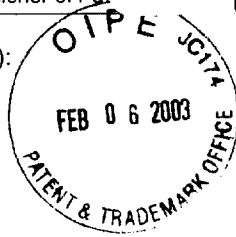

ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, **ASH, Leslie E.; WIEBEL, Michael F.; ELVEN, Darren R.; BURTON, Christopher L.; LEE, Ryan P.B.; and THOMAS, Micheal**, (hereinafter referred to singly and collectively as "ASSIGNOR") have invented a certain invention entitled **REAL-TIME STREAMING MEDIA MEASUREMENT SYSTEM AND METHOD** for which an application for United States Letters Patent was filed on **June 19, 2002** as Application No. **10/174,481**; and

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

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
