



ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, CASTLE INC, a California corporation having offices at 1364 N. McDowell Blvd., #1, Petaluma, California 94954 (hereinafter termed "Assignor") acquired the entire worldwide right, title and interest in and to a certain United States patent application (Serial No. 09/640267, filed August 17, 2000), the invention set forth in said application, the United States Patent issuing on said application (U.S. 6,481,259 B1, issued November 19, 2002 and entitled METHOD FOR PRECISION BENDING OF A SHEET OF MATERIAL AND SLIT SHEET THEREFOR), (collectively hereinafter the "Invention"), by an Assignment dated August 10, 2000 and recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on August 17, 2000 at Reel 011056, Frame 0161 (4 pages), and acquired all rights in foreign countries in the Invention including the international patent application under the Patent Cooperation Treaty filed August 16, 2001 and identified as International Application No. PCT/US01/41742; and

WHEREAS, INDUSTRIAL ORIGAMI, INC. (hereinafter termed "Assignee"), a corporation of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at 434 Payran Street, Suite A, Petaluma, State of California 94952, is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said Invention, and in and to all embodiments of the Invention, heretofore conceived, made or discovered by the inventor and in and to any and all patents, including U.S. Patent No. 6,481,259 B1, all inventor's certificates and other forms of protection (hereinafter termed the "Patents") thereon granted in the United States and/or in foreign countries, including patents based upon International Application No. PCT/US01/41742.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of good and valuable consideration acknowledged by said Assignor to have been received in full from said Assignee:

1. Said Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey unto said Assignee, the entire right, title and interest (a) in and to said U.S. application, said U.S. Patent, said International Application, and said Invention; (b) in and to all rights to apply for foreign Patents on said Invention pursuant to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property or otherwise; (c) in and to any and all applications filed and any and all Patents granted on said Invention in the United States or any foreign country, including each and every application filed and each and every Patent granted on any application which is a division,

substitution, or continuation of any of said applications; and (d) in and to each and every reissue or extensions of any of said Patents; and (e) all claims for damages by reason of past infringement of said Patents, with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and enjoyment, and for use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

2. Said Assignor hereby covenants and agrees to cooperate with said Assignee to enable said Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right title and interest herein conveyed in the United States and foreign countries. Such cooperation by said Assignor shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by said Assignee (a) for perfecting in said Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of said applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said Invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any said Patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said Invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said Invention and any applications therefore and any Patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Assignor in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Assignor, its successors, legal representatives and assigns.
