ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

Be it known that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by said Assignor, said Assignor, by these presents, has sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to said Assignee, the said inventions and the Patent and any reissue or reissues, and extensions thereof, of said letters patent already granted and which may be granted, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee for its own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to the end of the term or terms for which said letters patent of the United States are or may be granted or reissued as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the said Assignor if this assignment and sale had not been made; together with all income, royalties, damages and payments now and hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect to said letters patent and applications and aforementioned assigned rights, including, without limitation, the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof and all rights and damages corresponding thereto throughout the world.

Assignor agrees to execute promptly all documents and perform all acts reasonably requested by assignee as may be necessary to vest Assignee fully in title in and to said letters patent and applications and aforementioned assigned rights, and to record Assignee's interest therein.

This Assignment of Patent Rights shall insure to the benefit of Assignee and its successors and assigns who shall have the right to assign, license or otherwise transfer any of the rights granted under this Assignment of Patent Rights.

And, said Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue any and all letters patent of the United States, or country foreign to the United States, on said inventions or resulting from said applications or any division or divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part or reissues thereof to the said Assignee as assignee of the entire interest, and hereby covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that it has not executed, and will not execute, any agreements in contravention hereof.
