

ASSIGNMENT BEFORE PATENT (herein "Assignment")

SECTION 1 Background

We, Christopher O. Jaynes, Ph.D and Stephen B. The Inventors hereby agree to fully execute all documents or papers necessary for obtaining Letters Patent in the United States and elsewhere, and to furnish all data, information, and documentation which may be required for the preparation, filing, and prosecution of applications for said Letters Patent.


