And said Assignor does hereby covenant and agree, for himself and his legal representatives, that he will assist said Assignee in the prosecution of the applications herein identified; in the making and prosecuting of any other applications for Letters Patent that said Assignee may elect to make covering the invention herein identified, as herein above set forth;


