ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT

WHEREAS, Gary H. Murphy (hereinafter ASSIGNOR) of 28 Barlett St. #4 Beverly, MA 01915, is the owner of a certain invention entitled "Occupant Restraint system with compartmentalization," which is the subject of U.S. Patent No. 6,312,056, publicly issued June 27, 2002 to Gary H. Murphy;

Industrial Property, Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Designs and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements to which the United States of America adheres; and the ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent to ASSIGNEE, for his interest as ASSIGNEE, his successors, assigns, and legal representatives.

This transaction brings the Assignees total undivided interest in the above Patent to five percent (5%). For reference see Assignment of Patent between John A. Donlon (Assignee) and Gary H. Murphy (Assignor) dated December 16, 2001.2

Assignees interest cannot be assigned, conveyed, or otherwise transferred without the prior written consent of Assignor.

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees to transfer a like interest upon request of said ASSIGNEE, his successors, assigns, and legal representatives, and without further remuneration, in and to any improvements, and applications for patents based thereon, growing out of or related to the said invention;

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees to execute any papers by ASSIGNEE, his successors, assigns, and legal representatives, deemed essential to ASSIGNEE'S full protection and title in and to the invention hereby transferred;


ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment;


ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE agree that this Agreement shall not be amended
except in writing by each of the Parties; and


ASSIGNOR hereby agrees, upon request of ASSIGNEE, and without further

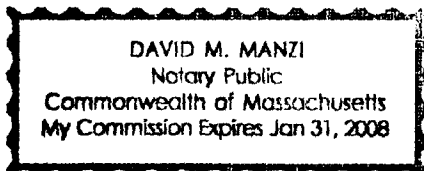


