

(U.S. and Foreign Rights)

WHEREAS, We, Joel Scott Scarbrough of 33614 Ridge Lane, Burlington, Wisconsin 53105; Daniel C. Faul of 415 Jefferson Street, West Bend, Wisconsin 53090; and Louis LaSorsa of P.O. Box 804, Waynesboro, Pennsylvania 17268 (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNORS), have made new and useful inventions and improvements for which we an application for Letters Patent of the United States was executed on February 28, 2003, and entitled REFLECTIVE ARTICLE AND METHOD OF MANUFACTURING SAME, claiming the benefit of U.S. Application Number 10/239,670, filed on September 24, 2002;

AND WHEREAS, Serigraph Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, having a place of business at 3801 E.
