WHEREAS, WE, DONALD A. COOKE, of 3704 Coopers Farm Road, Greensboro, North Carolina 27406, and KENNETH M. MCGOVERN, of 431 Meadowood Drive, Burlington, North Carolina 27215 have invented certain new and useful improvements for a FIBER SPLICE TRAY FOR USE IN OPTICAL FIBER HYDROPHONE ARRAY, for which we have made application for Letters Patent of the United States, which application has been duly filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on June 28, 2003, and assigned United States patent application number 10/604157;

And we do hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S.A., and any officials of foreign countries whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all said Letters Patent, when granted, in accordance with the terms of this assignment.

We further covenant and agree that, when requested, we will, without demanding any further consideration therefor but at the expense of Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining, sustaining or reissuing United States or foreign Letters Patent for the said invention, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to said invention and Letters Patent particularly in cases of interference and litigation.

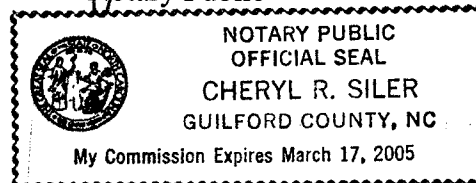
