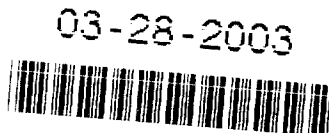

Whereas, we, Patricia Alred of Frederick, Maryland, Scott A. Cook of Garner, North Carolina, Wytold R. Lebing of Clayton, North Carolina, Douglas C. Lee of Apex, North Carolina, Hanns-Ingolf Paul of Leverkusen, Germany, and Klaus-Peter Radtke of Apex, North Carolina, have invented a new and useful Improvement in CHROMATOGRAPHIC METHOD FOR HIGH YIELD PURIFICATION AND VIRAL INACTIVATION OF ANTIBODIES for which an application for United States Letters Patent was filed on October 15 , 2002 and assigned Serial No. 10/270,918.

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


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
