AND WHEREAS, DONALDSON COMPANY, INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, and having an office and place of business at 1400 West 94th Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, 55440 (hereinafter "Donaldson") is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions, improvements and applications and in and to the Letters Patent or Patents to be obtained therefor, including the U.S. Patent No. 6,235,377 issued on May 22, 2001 and all its pending continuations and foreign counterparts shown in Appendix A;

NOW THEREFORE, to all whom it may concern, be it known that for and in consideration of the execution of a license dated September 27, 2001 signed by both Bio Med and Donaldson and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency whereof is hereby acknowledged, Bio Med has sold, assigned, and transferred, and by this document does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto Donaldson, its successors or assigns, the entire right, title and interest for all countries in and to all inventions and improvements disclosed in the aforesaid patent and applications, and in and to the applications, all divisions, continuations, or renewals thereof, all Letters Patent or Patents which may be granted therefrom, including the U.S. Patent No. 6,235,377 issued on May 22, 2001, and all continuations, reissues or extensions of such patents, and in and to any and all applications which have been or shall be filed in any foreign countries for Letters Patent on the inventions and improvements, including an assignment of all rights under the provisions of the International Convention, and all Letters Patent of foreign countries which may be granted therefrom, including those applications shown in Appendix A; and Bio Med does hereby authorize and request the U.S. Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and the appropriate Governmental Authority of foreign countries to issue any and all United States Letters Patent or Patents and any and all foreign country Letters Patent or Patents respectively for the aforesaid inventions and improvements to Donaldson as the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for the use of Donaldson, its successors and assigns.


This assignment is to become retroactively effective as of September 27, 2001.

AND, for the consideration aforesaid, Bio Med does hereby agree that the inventors and Bio Med and their successors, assigns, executors and legal representatives will make, execute and deliver any and all other instruments in writing including any and all further application papers, affidavits, assignments and other documents, and will communicate to Donaldson, its successors and representatives all facts known to it relating to said improvements and the history thereof and will testify in all legal proceedings and generally do all things which may be necessary or desirable more effectually to secure to and vest in Donaldson, its successors or assigns the entire right, title and interest in and to the improvements, inventions, applications, Letters Patent or Patents, rights, titles, benefits, privileges and advantages hereby sold, assigned and conveyed, or intended so to be, including the U.S. Patent No. 6,235,377 issued on May 22, 2001 and all its pending continuations and foreign counterparts shown in Appendix A.

AND, furthermore Bio Med covenants and agrees with said Donaldson, its successors and assigns, that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the rights and property herein conveyed has been made to others by it and that full right to convey the same as herein expressed is possessed by it.



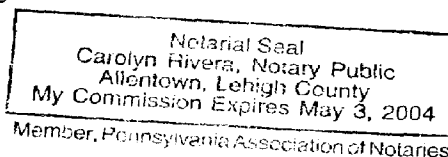

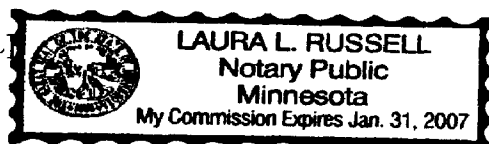
