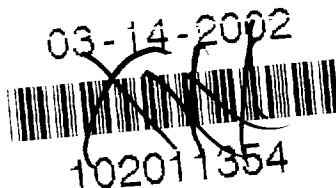

Roosevelt, Wichita, Kansas 67208 in connection with said invention of a new, original, novel and unique **CLEANING MITT** ("Invention").

I assign, transfer, and convey to Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to

- (a) the Invention;
- (b) the Petition for Design Patent, filed on NOVEMBER 19, 2001;
- (c) the application for United States Letters Patent executed by me and/or filed on _____, 2001;
- (d) any Letters Patent issued pursuant to, or as a result of, the application referenced above;

- (e) perform any and all affirmative acts to obtain Letters Patent and vest all right in such Letters Patent in Assignee; and
- (f) perform such additional acts as Assignee may deem necessary or expedient in connection with any of the matters stated above.

4. I covenant and warrant that as of the date of this Assignment Agreement, I am the true and lawful owner of the entire right, title, and interest in the Invention, the Petition for Design Patent, application for Letters Patent, and any Letters Patent which may issue under said application, and have the full right and power to convey the same; that the same are free and clear of all liens, charges and encumbrances whatsoever; and that I have not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict with this Assignment Agreement.

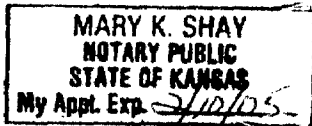
