and which is found in U.S. Patent No. 5,659,680, issued on August 19, 1997, and any legal equivalent thereof in a foreign country, including the right to claim priority, and, in and to, all Letters Patent to be obtained for said invention by the above applications or any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, renewals, or substitutes thereof, and as to letters patent any reissues, re-examinations, or extensions thereof including all rights of action in relation to any infringement of the Patent by third parties at or prior to the date hereof, to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE for its own use as fully and entirely as to same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR had this Assignment not been made.

ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment.

ASSIGNOR further covenants that ASSIGNEE will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said invention and said Letters Patent and legal equivalents as may be know and accessible to ASSIGNOR and will testify as to the same in any interference, litigation or proceeding related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to ASSIGNEE or its legal representatives any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and enforce said application, said invention and said Letters Patent and said equivalents thereof which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes thereof.
