ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Schott Glas, a German foundation ("Schott Glas"), Schott Optovance, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Optovance"), Schott Fiber Optics, a division of Schott North America, Inc., a Maryland Corporation ("Optics", collectively with Schott Corporation, Schott Glas and Optovance (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNORS"), are the owners of all right, title and interest in and to the inventions, and the corresponding issued U.S. Patents or pending U.S. Patent Applications listed in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, Molex Incorporated, a Delaware corporation, having a place of business at 2222 Wellington Court, Lisle, Illinois 60532 (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE"), is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions, said U.S. Patents and said U.S. Patent Applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said ASSIGNORS, hereby sell, assign, and transfer and set over, unto ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in, to and under said inventions, said United States Patents and said United States Patent Applications listed in Exhibit A attached hereto, including all divisions, renewals, and continuations thereof, and all Patents of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues, reexaminations and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which have been filed or may hereafter be filed for said inventions in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial property protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models and designs which may be granted for said inventions in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals, reexaminations and reissues thereof, including the right to sue for past infringements;

ASSIGNORS HEREBY authorize and request the Commissioner for Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property protection on applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

ASSIGNORS HEREBY grant Charles S. Cohen, Registration No. 32,210, the power to insert in this Assignment any further identification or information which may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with the rules of the United States Patent and Trademark Office for recordation of this document.


ASSIGNORS HEREBY covenant and agree that they have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, that no rights, licenses or privileges of any kind have been granted concerning the interest herein assigned, and that he has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

ASSIGNORS HEREBY further covenant and agree that they will communicate to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known or available to him respecting said inventions, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue, reexamination and foreign applications, make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries.
