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ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, **Duane R. Pillar** of 1733 Iowa Street, Oshkosh, Wisconsin 54902; **Neil Bjornstad** of 150 Westbrook Drive, Oshkosh, Wisconsin 54904; **William M. Woolman** of 4926 9th Street Road, Oshkosh, Wisconsin 54904 and **Bradley C. Squires** of Northgate Estates, Lot 16, New London, Wisconsin 54961; (hereinafter referred to singly and collectively as "ASSIGNOR") have invented a certain invention entitled **TURRET OPERATOR INTERFACE SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR A FIRE FIGHTING VEHICLE** (Atty. Dkt. ASSIGNOR HEREBY AUTHORIZES AND REQUESTS the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent to ASSIGNEE as assignee of the entire interest, for the sole use and benefit of ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns.

ASSIGNOR HEREBY AGREES (a) to communicate to ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, or their representatives or agents, all facts and information known or available to ASSIGNOR respecting said invention or inventions, improvements, and modifications including evidence for interference, reexamination, reissue, opposition, revocation, extension, or infringement purposes or other legal, judicial, or administrative proceedings,
