

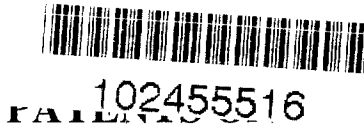

and executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States of America therefor; and


